Scott does not use shortcuts, gimmicky equipment or ‘ten easy steps’. While never using force or fear, he applies common sense methods and very personalized training to help the rider achieve partnership with his or her horse using the smallest of efforts based on the concepts of feel, timing, balance, release and reward.

Scott’s work is heavily influenced by Bill and Tom Dorrance, Ray Hunt and Buck Brannaman, who may be called practitioners of foundation horsemanship, vaquero horsemanship, or more loosely, natural horsemanship. This is a natural and effective method of communicating with horses using careful, patient and positive cues for each horse.

Each clinic session is tailored to individual participant’s concerns and each horse’s individual needs. Clinics may include work loose in a round pen, ground work with a lariat or halter, or mounted work. Scott’s quiet, gentle and straightforward training style has proven to be very effective with all types and ages of horses.
